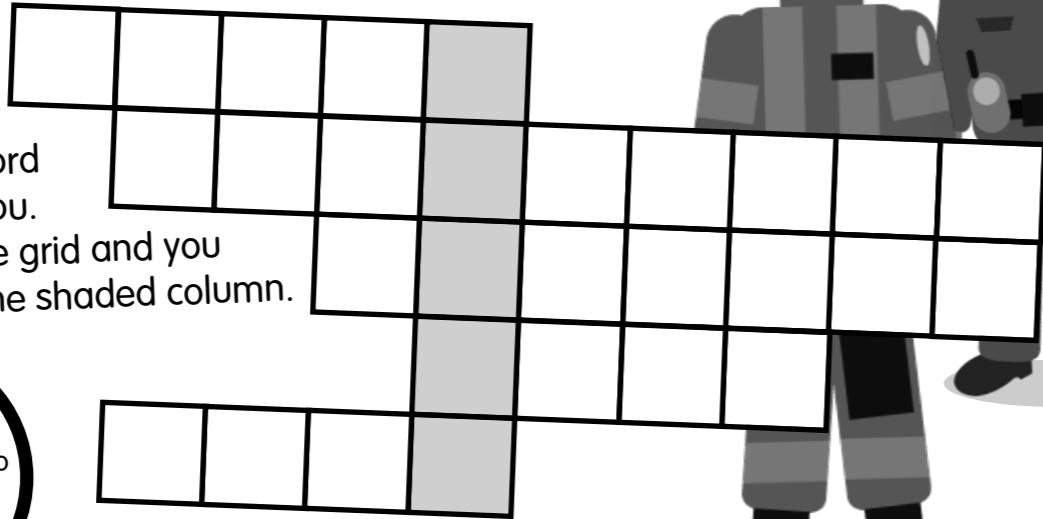


Gridlocked

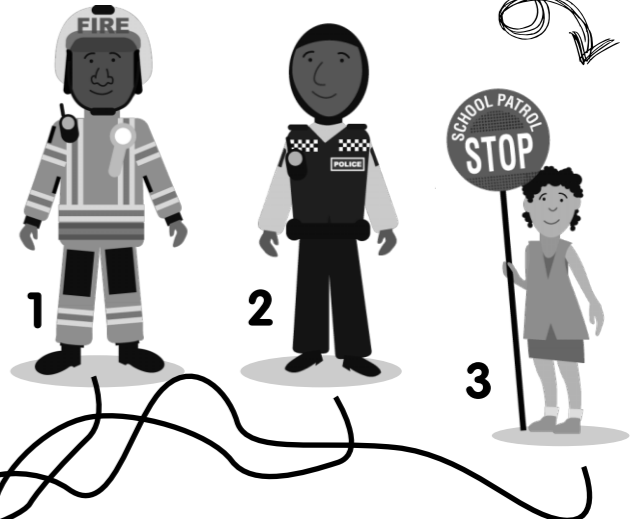
